

1. INCIDENT REPORTING

All Incidents must be reported to the race directors within 24 hours of the event completing, after such time the report will not be considered.

After the time period all incidents will be laid out as follows.

- 1.1 All Incidents being reported will be listed on Facebook as information only.
- 1.2 After the reporting time has elapsed the incidents will be investigated by the Race Directors.
- 1.3 Any penalties will be posted on to the Facebook page.
- 1.4 There will be a 24 hour time period to appeal against the penalty (with corroborating evidence).
- 1.5 After the appeals time period has elapsed all penalties outstanding will be fully implemented.
- 1.6 Full Race points will then be updated

2. DRIVER PENALTY POINTS

The Driver penalty points system is a method of accruing punishments from incidents in the SCW/WECFF Season. Each Driver entered, has a maximum of twelve (12) points that can be accrued before action is undertaken on the driver. Points remain against the driver for a period of a full season before they are removed.

However, if the twelve-point limit is reached by a driver, the Driver will be suspended for the following event, effectively forcing a one-race ban onto the driver. The points will be removed once the driver returns.

The driver penalty points are applied to which ever series the driver is entered and will be applied against that series.

3. ATTENDING EVENTS

Due to the complexity of the SCW/WECFF Series and the time constraints on the organisers we have a system in place for entries to each event.

- 3.1** All events will be made public 7-10 Days before the start date, all tagged entries must inform the race director if they are ATTENDING or NOT, this must be made no later than 24 hours before the start time. (Exceptional circumstances excepted), if an entry fails to advise the race directors, then a points penalty will be applied to them.
-10 points off Championship Score.
- 3.2** If Any entry advises they are racing and fails to turn up without notice, the race directors will then apply a penalty will to them.
-10 points off Championship Score.
- 3.3** If an entry fails to advise a non-start or does not turn up for 3 events in a row.
They will be dropped from that series.
- 3.4** Exceptions to the rules are only considered if prior agreements have been arranged with the Race Directors
(For Example, only racing certain times, only racing when time permits, Joker races).

4. IN RACE PENALTIES

Gran Turismo hands out in race penalties, which we require all entries to clear where required for the lap/race entered.

- 4.1** Entries are forbidden from finishing a lap with any outstanding penalties against them. Any time penalty incurred by an entry during the race must be cleared before the finish line of the current lap (or where indicated) and off the racing line.

PENALTY: 2 Driver Penalty Points (Per Offence)

This is for races on GT Sport. Races held on GT7 will automatically clear the in-race penalties accrued.

- 4.2** Entries are forbidden from finishing a race with any outstanding penalties against them.

PENALTY: 3 Driver Penalty Points (Per Offence)

This is for races on GT Sport, Races held on GT7 (See Below).

GT7 ONLY: Last lap penalties that are unable to be cleared will be checked by the race directors to ensure that this was the case, if the game automatically adds the penalty to the finish time this will stand, if the game does not and entry has an outstanding penalty then a time penalty of 2 seconds will be added to overall finish time.

Race directors will stress that this is not a cause for people to continue to finish with penalties. If that continues, then the race directors will impose the driver penalty points.

5. GENERAL RACE PENALTIES

All Series will adhere to these penalties.

The penalties are set as a Per Offence system.

- 5.1 Re-joining the track in an unsafe manner.
PENALTY: 1 Driver Point
- 5.2 Failed to make a mandatory Pit stop when requested.
PENALTY: 1 Driver Point
- 5.3 Crossing the white line at pit entry/Exit. (GT7 If implemented)
PENALTY: 1 Driver Point
- 5.4 Leaving the track and gaining a lasting advantage.
PENALTY: 5 Seconds / 1 Driver Point
- 5.5 Gaining position by passing with Penalty time.
PENALTY: 5 Seconds / 1 Driver Point
- 5.6 Impeding someone - during qualifying.
PENALTY: 5 Seconds / 1 Driver Point
- 5.7 Impeding someone - during a race.
PENALTY: 5 Seconds / 1 Driver Point
- 5.8 Gaining/Not returning position after a collision.
PENALTY: 10 Seconds / 2 Driver Points
- 5.9 Braked in a way such as to cause a collision.
PENALTY: 10 Seconds / 2 Driver Points
- 5.10 Causing an avoidable collision.
PENALTY: 20 Seconds / 2 Driver Points
- 5.11 Forcing a car off the track.
PENALTY: 30 Seconds / 3 Driver Points
- 5.12 Deliberately causing a collision or forcing someone off track.
PENALTY: DISQUALIFIED
